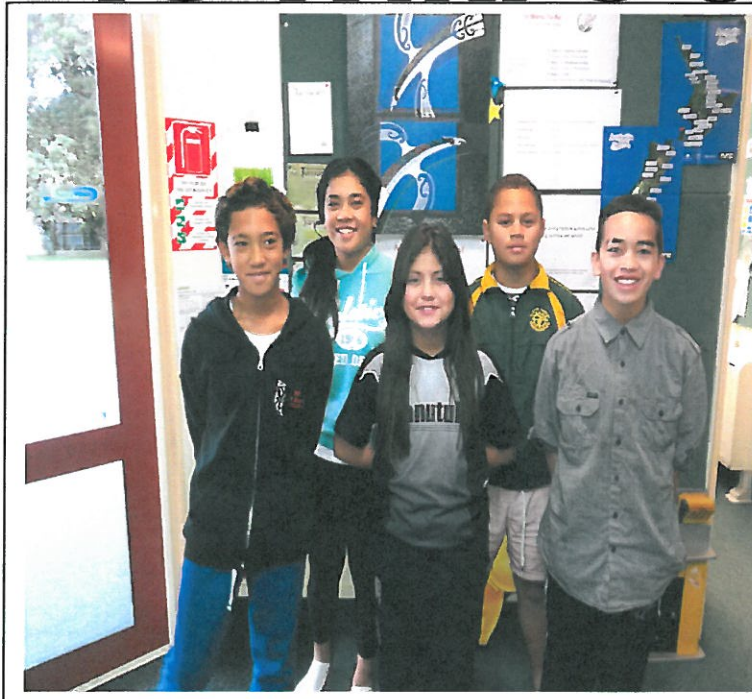
Te Manu e kawea tonutia! Te Manu e whakaahurutia! Te Manu Tu Ke!
