BUS Support and Monitoring!

Thank you parents or caregivers, who bring bus concerns straight to the school. Thus Papa Taharakau Stewart has refreshed the Bus Seating Plan idea for the Kaiti Bus. This will take the pressure off of our Bus Monitors, whose job is to monitor and not to discipline. **Please know that** the monitors report matters of concern to:

1. Matua Pare Tureia: Teacher in charge of Campion Bus matters.
2. Papa Taharakau Stewart: Teacher in charge of Kaiti Bus matters.
3. These kaiako then bring the SERIOUS reports to the principal.

Bus Reminders please!

1. Children must SIT down please; no kneeling.
2. NO eating please.
3. Casual Users of the bus must seek permission from the Office prior to the day please. This includes our high school pupils who want to visit us when their High School has a T.o.D. There is a **\$2 cost for one-way usage**.
4. NO violence to another child.

N.B. Instant removal of a child from the bus will occur if a child uses violence or abuse to another child. This decision and the length of time of loss of bus-use will be made solely by the principal.
