Come meet Koka Mitch this Monday night to confirm your day – either Monday or Tuesday – thank you.

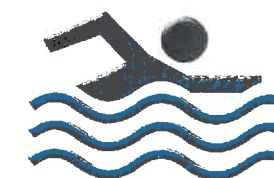
The SWIM SAFE programme

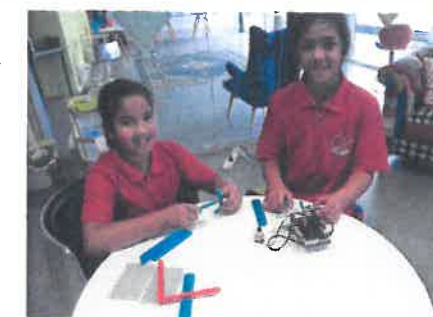
Te MIND LAB!
