**11.11.15: 6p.m.** The power of the CHILD was evidenced by the ten whanau members who turned up at the school's 2<sup>nd</sup> Whanau CAMHS Hui. Students went home and insisted that their Mum or in one case both Mum and Dad come to the Hui.

The numbers were lower than the 1<sup>st</sup> Hui but the outcomes were still very important.

Dr Diana Rangihuna spoke about "Mahi a Atua" which draws from Maori creation and custom stories to promote conversations that bring about a shift of awareness for young people in distress. These stories promote *Matauranga Maori* as therapeutic and encourage personal resilience and creativity to find meaningful solutions for each individual. "Mahi a Atua" requires community support to ensure mental health services meet the needs of the whanau it provides services to" reported Dr Diana.

Working with Manutuke School was amazing" says Dr Rangihuna. We are the first school to engage with CAMHS professionals in this encompassing and whanau-like manner.
