Daily guided writing, daily instructional reading or tuakana-teina reading for mileage and skill building, and daily targeted mathematics means these room 3 children are highly engaged and motivated to always do their best. The class has a very tight framework as Koka Helen takes reading recovery also. Thus they must also integrate their topic studies into their literacy programme to give sound understanding and learning.



The progress that these room 9 akonga make on a daily basis is all due, to solid 1-1 or level-group planning, effective use of the kaiawhina i te reo, having very high expectations for each child – no matter how young they are and ensuring success for each akonga. Koka Waina with Koka Kimi, commit and purposefully work also to gain high-class Te Reo Maori and tikanga achievements and outputs for each akonga.



These room 7 akonga are trialling Koka Keita Ngata's oral programme, for Kura Maori through a Ministry, TLIF funded project, that she devised for 7 year olds. Each student's reo is tested, recorded word-by-word and then analysed purposefully. The follow-up stage of planned, targeted teaching is totally oral, using games, challenges and activities. Amazing acceleration in each child's outputs across Koka Mel's literacy programmes is evident.

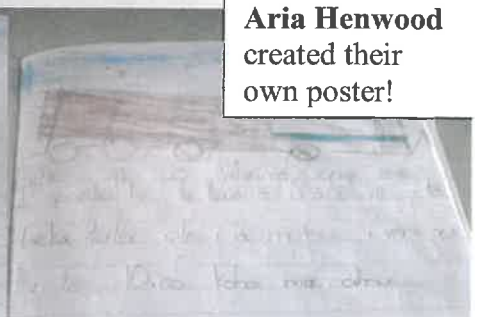
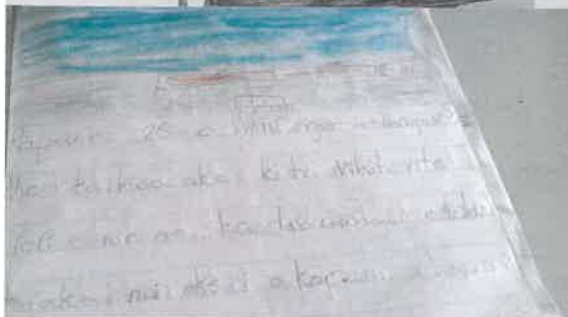
